

KEYNOTE SPEAKERS



Wyoming swimming has been a part of Tom Johnson's life for a little more than two decades. Johnson swam at the University of Wyoming for four years, he spent one season as an assistant coach, and for the last 19 years has been head coach. He currently is the process of opening a SwimLabs swim school in Las Vegas, NV.

Over the past 19 seasons at the helm of the Wyoming swimming and diving program, Johnson has led the Cowboys and Cowgirls to their highest conference finishes ever and has been named conference coach of the year four times. At UW, he has seen 32 individual Mountain West Champions, seven Western Athletic Conference Champions, four individual Mountain Pacific Sports Federation (MPSF) Champions, three Honorable Mention All-Americans and 11 student-athletes earn Academic All-America honors. He also coached the Cowgirls first back-to-back Honorable Mention All-American in Kelsey Conci.

Johnson has also coached over 60 individual Academic All-Americans in his time at Wyoming. A native of Camillus, N.Y., Johnson was a four-year Wyoming letter winner as he swam for the Cowboys from 1982-85. Prior to becoming the head swimming and diving coach at Wyoming in 1998, Johnson was the head coach and program director for the Birmingham Swim League in Birmingham, Ala., from the novice level to Olympic trial qualifiers. He guided the Birmingham Swim League from 1994 to 1997, and had 16 swimmers go on to compete at the NCAA Division I level across the United States. Johnson is also a USA Swimming National Team Coach. Johnson and his wife, Cheryl, a native of Cheyenne, have two children, Tommy and Alexandra.

KEYNOTE SPEAKERS



Stu Marvin just completed his tenth season as the head coach of the men's & women's swim teams at Bloomsburg University. As a former swimmer at Bloomsburg, Marvin was a five-time conference champion and an eleven time NCAA All American.

Since his return to Bloomsburg, the men's team posted their first undefeated season in program history and has broken every team record. A total of ten men have achieved All American honors and 14 can claim 51 conference titles. On the women's side, all but two records have been broken with five women being named All American. Eleven women can claim 30 conference titles.

Marvin returned to Bloomsburg after spending 30 years in Fort Lauderdale, Florida, where he managed the aquatic complex at the International Swimming Hall of Fame. He coached with the Fort Lauderdale Swim Team and Fort Lauderdale Aquatics. Marvin was also an administrator for the College Swimming Coaches Association of America (CSCAA) during their annual Swim Forum.



Marc Christian is in his second season with Pitt swimming & diving as an assistant swimming coach and the program's director of operations.

In his first campaign with the Panthers, both teams took impressive steps forward as a total 20 school records were broken, including 12 men's program bests and eight women's school records. The Pitt men's swimming & diving team also posted its highest points total in program history at the ACC Championships, placing 10th with 513.0 points.
