The Denison swimming & diving program
has become synonymous with success at the
national level and behind that success over the
past 29 years has been head coach Gregg
Parini. Under Parini's watch his teams have
captured four national championships, 16
national runner-up finishes in addition to
Denison's current streak of 58 consecutive top-

A 10-time NCAA National Coach of the Year, Parini's men's swimming & diving team won its third national championship in 2016, outdistancing second-place Kenyon by 37 points.

At the conference level, Parini has coached Denison to 17 conference titles and has earned the North Coast Athletic Conference Coach of the Year award, 17 times. DU has produced over 350 All-Americans that have racked up over 2,000 All-American swims. Twenty-four Denison swimmers and divers have been awarded the prestigious NCAA Postgraduate Scholarship and in 2004, former Denison swimmer Darius Grigaliunas swam in the Olympics as a member of the Lithuanian team.

Parini also has an equally impressive career as an educator and Associate Professor at Denison.

Darren Suroviec Head Coach-Gannon University
The Gannon University Swimming and
Diving program is being revitalized in athleticism,
academic prowess and culture under Suroviec as
he prepares to enter his third season as lead of
the program.

Suroviec had a stellar first season as the program made history by producing its first ever individual champions in the PSAC conference. In Suroviec's last two seasons, several school records have fallen, 13 NCAA "B" cut times have been recorded, and the team earned 27 All-PSAC honors.

Academically, the program is reaching new highs under Suroviec's lead. During the 2016-2017, the Golden Knights Women's and Men's team earned the 13th and 16th highest team GPA NCAA DIVISION II. Furthermore, the women's team earned 3rd highest GPA in the PSAC conference, while the men's team earned the highest GPA.
